

2021 Bachelor of Business Domestic Academic Achievement Scholarship

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scholarship Summary

AIHE welcomes applications from Year 12 domestic students or equivalent, who are commencing their studies in 2021, and domestic higher education students who would like to continue their education with AIHE. This Scholarship is provided to encourage domestic students to undertake and complete the undergraduate Bachelor of Business at Adelaide Institute of Higher Education. It will be awarded in duration for one year, up to the duration of their undergraduate degree.

Value

The Scholarship rewards successful applicants with a tuition fee reduction during their enrolment in the Bachelor of Business course. The value of the scholarship is determined by the applicant's academic achievement on entry to the course and in subsequent years of study at AIHE¹.

A maximum of 50 BBus Academic Achievement Scholarships may be awarded in any calendar year.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship you must be a prospective or current domestic student who meets AIHE's minimum academic and English language requirements. The scholarship is available to commencing and continuing domestic students enrolling in subjects in the Bachelor of Business³. Scholarships are limited to the first 50 successful applicants.

Scholarship Name	2021 Adelaide Institute of Higher Education Bachelor of Business Academic Achievement Scholarship		
Scholarship Value	The scholarship provides a reduction in tuition fees of between 60% and 100% for subjects enrolled in AIHE's Bachelor of Business based on the applicant's academic achievement prior to entry or in their previous year of study at AIHE.		
Scholarship Duration	The scholarship applies for three years for full-time students and six years for part-time students. The duration will be varied where the student receives credit transfer or recognition of prior learning		
Number of Scholarships	A maximum of 50 Scholarships may be awarded in any calendar year.		
Delivery of Scholarship	Scholarship payments (60, 70, 80 or 100% of tuition fees) will be provided as a tuition fee waiver. The amount will be deducted from the student's contribution invoice (tuition fee) at the commencement of the study period.		
	The scholarship does not cover the costs of travel, accommodation, living expenses, books and study materials or any other expenses associated with living in Adelaide or study at the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education.		
Conditions	 Higher Education. Applicant must meet normal program admission requirements for the Bachelor of Business. Scholarships are limited to the first 50 successful applicants. Applicants must apply using the approved Scholarship Application Form. Recipients will be selected based on the published selection criteria for the coursework scholarship. Selection is undertaken in accordance with the Scholarship Terms and Conditions. This Scholarship is not paid for subjects where credit is granted in recognition of prior learning/study. This Scholarship is not is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash. A Scholarship recipient must commence and complete the subject/s in the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education of Adelaide in the nominated study periods. This Scholarship recipient is required to enrol in the Bachelor of Business subject/s where the Scholarship applies. The Terms and Conditions applicable to payment of fees do not change with the awarding of this Scholarship. The Scholarship recipient must pay their tuition fees within the stipulated payment deadlines.
