TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scholarship Summary

Value

The Scholarship rewards successful applicants with a 30% tuition fee reduction. The scholarship applies to the first year of study only, up to a maximum of two semesters. A maximum of 20 Scholarships may be awarded.

Eligibility

This scholarship is available to all onshore international students enrolling in the Bachelor of Business in 2020. Scholarships are limited to the first 20 successful applicants.

Scholarship Name	The Adelaide Institute of Higher Education 2020 Bachelor of Business Scholarship (Onshore International)
Scholarship Value	The scholarship provides a 30% reduction in tuition fees for subjects enrolled in the first year of study.
Scholarship Duration	The scholarship applies to the first year of study only, up to a maximum of two semesters.
Number of Scholarships	A maximum of 20 Scholarships may be awarded in 2020.
Delivery of scholarship	Scholarship payments (30% of tuition fees) will be provided as a tuition fee waiver. The amount will be deducted from the student's contribution invoice (tuition fee) at the commencement of each applicable study period in the first year of study.
	The scholarship does not cover the costs of visas, Overseas Student Health Cover, travel, accommodation, living expenses, books and study materials or any other expenses associated with living in Adelaide or study at the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education.
Scholarship conditions	 This Scholarship is available to onshore international students** enrolling in their first year of study at Adelaide Institute of Higher Education in 2020. Applicant must be eligible to study in Australia. Applicant must meet normal program admission requirements for the Bachelor of Business. Scholarships are limited to the first 20 successful applicants. Applicants must apply using the approved Scholarship Application Form. Recipients will be selected based on the published selection criteria for the coursework scholarship. Selection is undertaken in accordance with the Scholarship Terms and Conditions.

- 7. The following students are not eligible to receive this Scholarship:
 - a. Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia
 - b. Current Adelaide Institute of Higher Education students
 - c. Students who are recipients of a scholarship awarded by a recognised scholarship awarding body such as a government ministry or department.
- 8. This Scholarship is not paid for subjects where credit is granted in recognition of prior learning/study.
- 9. This Scholarship is not is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash.
- 10. A Scholarship recipient must commence study in the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education of Adelaide in the Semester for which the scholarship is offered.
- 11. This Scholarship cannot be deferred.
- 12. The Scholarship recipient is required to enrol in the Bachelor of Business as an international student* and must maintain international student* status for the duration of their enrolment in the study periods where the Scholarship has been awarded.
- 13. This Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient ceases to be an international student*.
- 14. The Scholarship recipient is required to enrol in a full-time study load for each study period where the Scholarship applies.
- 15. If a Scholarship recipient enrols in more than the standard full-time unit load required for the year, or in any way accrues additional tuition fee liabilities, the additional tuition fees are not covered by this Scholarship.
- 16. The Terms and Conditions applicable to payment of fees do not change with the awarding of this Scholarship.
- 17. The Scholarship recipient must pay their tuition fees within the stipulated payment deadlines.
- 18. If the Scholarship recipient enrols in courses in another institution, including cross-institutional study, those tuition fees are not covered by this Scholarship.
- 19. If the Scholarship recipient is required to repeat a subject the student is liable to pay for the tuition fees for the repeated subject.
- 20. The Scholarship recipient agrees to notify the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education immediately if they intend to:
 - a. Discontinue full-time study
 - b. Transfer to another institution
 - c. Seek a retrospective withdrawal from any courses they have enrolled in
 - d. Defer their studies and/or apply for Approved Leave.
- 21. The Adelaide Institute of Higher Education reserves the right to vary the award, withdraw or not to offer this Scholarship if:
 - a. the Scholarship recipient has not achieved or ceases to meet the eligibility requirements of this Scholarship; or
 - b. the Scholarship recipient is found to have supplied incorrect or misleading information during the application process; or
 - c. the Scholarship recipient fails to maintain good academic standing and progress; or
 - d. there is a case of serious misconduct by the Scholarship recipient; or
 - e. in any other case where the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education determines that the Scholarship eligibility requirements have not been met.
- 22. The Scholarship recipient may be asked to participate in activities for the promotion of this Scholarship and Adelaide Institute of Higher Education and must willing to be featured in promotional collateral produced by the Institute.

^{*}An international student is a student who is not an Australian Citizen, a New Zealand Citizen or a holder of an Australia Permanent Residency Visa.

^{**} An international onshore student is an international student who is in Australia on a valid visa at the time of application.
